

The Master of Public Health, with a concentration in Health Education/Health Promotion, is a two-year program that educates its students through evidence-based approaches and experience in policy and research opportunities. Our program prepares students to analyze policy options and write clear policy statements, create methods for preventing and controlling environmental hazards that pose risks to human health and safety, and contribute to individuals and community health outcomes, to name a few!

## Be EXPERIENCED

Our graduates will attain the knowledge and skills required for the public health field and related careers. Our students will take classes led by internationally known faculty who are public health professionals that work for some of the following agencies:

- Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center
- Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
- National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH)
- The regional and local health department
- UC Health network

Our faculty will teach public health principles through a classroom curriculum cultivated through research findings of faculty researchers and practitioners. In addition, our students will complete 120 supervised hours working in a public health or healthcare agency to gain applied practice.
