After successfully completing the licensure program and passing state required licensure exams, you'll be eligible to apply for an initial state of Ohio teaching license to teach PreK-5th grade, as well as in a variety of settings, including public or private schools, preschools, head start programs, child-care centers, or related fields. Most graduates enlist to teach in Ohio, but our degree also satisfies teacher licensure requirements in multiple states.

There are four field placement experiences, which begins your freshman year. You will gain exposure in preschool, kindergarten, and primary grade classrooms in both public and private school settings. Our education programs include an urban teaching component to better prepare students to work with diverse populations. Through observations and over 1000 hours of practicum experiences and internships, you will develop knowledge essential to your career after college.
